Fourth Degree members are encouraged to attend. Sir Knights with the Fourth Degree Uniform are asked to participate in the Honor Guard for the Exemplification, Mass and banquet.

Dress for candidates & 4th Degree members: Black or dark (blue or grey) business suit with black socks and black shoes, white dress shirt (no button down collars or French cuffs) and tie. A black tuxedo is optional. But, if worn the tuxedo is worn with a white pleated tuxedo shirt with a lay-down collar (**no ruffles or French collars**) a black bow tie and cummerbund (**no vests**). We are honored to have active duty Military personnel and encourage them to wear their dress uniform.

Sponsors & Faithful Navigators should accompany their candidates. Do not allow a candidate to attend the degree alone. Candidates **must have a current third degree membership card in their possession** as it will be checked. The celebration of Mass & the banquet are essential parts of the degree and all candidates and families are expected and encouraged to participate in both.

<u>Ladies Entertainment</u>: The entertainment will start when candidate registration opens. Ladies are welcome to join the hosting auxiliary whenever their Knight comes to register. The auxiliary will provide lunch during candidate registration that will be salads and dessert. This will be followed by Kathy McGovern speaking on the history of holy week and that will be followed by some prize winning games. The program will conclude in time for a break and time to freshen up for the mass at 5PM.

COST: \$70.00 - fee for candidates: includes social baldric, lapel pin and a banquet ticket. Fee must accompany completed Form 4 "Fourth Degree Membership Document" and sent to registrar by date indicated.

Candidate's Guests and other Attendees

\$25.00 – fee for each member, spouse and adult guest attending banquet. Payment for guests and other attendees are to be included with registration and sent to registrar by the deadline date indicated. Special dietary needs need to be noted on registration meal requests. Banquet fees received are **NON-REFUNDABLE** after deadline date.

\$20.00 – fee for each priest attending the banquet. It is suggested that Assemblies should pay for any priest's banquet cost.

\$10.00 – fee for each child, ages 5-11 attending banquet. Children under 5 are free.

All checks payable to "MASTER OF THE DISTRICT" and sent with completed Form 4 and Registration Form must be received by the Registrar no later than February 15, 2020.

***Important: Be sure Form 4 includes: new member's membership number & signature

- 1. proposer signature & Assembly number
- 2. has been certified by Financial Secretary of the applicant's council, and
- 3. signed by both Faithful Navigator & Faithful Comptroller of Assembly he is joining
- 4. Leave Form 4 intact. Do not remove any pages from Form 4, as host assembly will return completed Assembly and Financial Secretary copy to a representative of assembly at the exemplification.

Faithful Navigators (or their designee) <u>MUST</u> register and send in <u>PAYMENTS</u> for all Candidates and Guests. Please register for the <u>Ladies Entertainment</u> and make note of any special dietary needs. Include <u>separate checks for each candidate!</u>

Because we expect a large number of candidates, all **Form 4's** (not scanned or digital) and all checks payable to **Master of the District** must be received by the registrar by February 15 or the registration will be considered late – no exceptions.

Registrations received after the deadline will be accommodated on a space available basis with every effort made to meet that accommodation. A <u>LATE FEE</u> of <u>\$10 per candidate</u> will be assessed to the Assembly for each candidate registered after the deadline.

To assist in the ease of registration, each Assembly submitting candidates should have a single point of contact for the Assembly with regard to their candidates and associated paperwork. When submitting Form 4's and associated paperwork, please submit **contact person's name and contact information**.

Upon the completion of the Exemplification a member of the candidate's assembly <u>needs</u> to meet with the 4th Degree registrar to pick up the Assembly and financial Secretary copies of the Form 4's for their new Sir Knights.
